
My.ipma offers digital badges to you to:

- » demonstrate your knowledge and skills are up to date


Step 1:

Make sure you have your individual account created and set up (for more information see *Creating your own personalised IPMA account* booklet).


Step 2: Go to My badges




Step 7: Activate your badge
